



## Information on the ICP Event

### **1. What documents are sent to the candidate prior to the event?**

The candidate will be emailed the Cisco ICP candidate FAQ document plus Innovise joining instructions

### **2. Structure of the 2 day ICP event (lab & presentation)**

The ICP event will consist of the following:

#### **Day 1 - Laboratory Test**

The Lab test is performed on the first day of the ICP.

ICP Candidates must be familiar with ALL equipment used in the ICND labs. This includes both the student and instructor equipment.

The Candidate is expected to be familiar with the lab setup and the student exercises. The Candidate needs to be fully experienced in the use of Cisco IOS. The Candidates are required to demonstrate configuration topics from the ICND1 and ICND2 courses as well as the ability to recover from student configuration errors.

#### **Day 2 - Presentations**

For the Presentation day, candidates should be prepared to teach any chapter from the ICND Course. Candidates will be asked to deliver two presentations. One presentation can be chosen by the candidate, the other will be selected by the ICP event proctor. Candidates also have the choice of delivering one presentation in a language of their choice by previous arrangement with Cisco Systems.

### **3. Start/Finish times**

Day 1 (Lab.) 8.30 am- 17.30pm

Day 2 (presentation) 9.00am - 17.30pm

### **4. What needs to happen in the event of a FAIL?**

At the end of the event the proctor emails the candidate result document to Cisco.

Candidate needs to wait 1 calendar month before re sitting the ICP event

### **5. What needs to happen in the event of a PASS?**

At the end of the event the proctor emails the candidate result document to Cisco.

The candidate will then receive confirmation from Cisco via their CLP or sponsored organization with a CCSI number.
